After Jesus rose from the dead, he spent a little time with his friends. He told them he could not stay with them, but that they must not be afraid.

He promised he would send the Holy Spirit to be with them. But they were afraid. They did not understand...

(From the Acts of the Apostles Chapters 1 and 2)

When the day of Pentecost came, all the believers were gathered together in one room, when something extraordinary happened. They described it afterwards as a great rushing wind that swept down from heaven and filled the whole house with the noise it made. Then separate little tongues of fire settled for a moment on the head of everyone there.

But what they could see and hear was nothing compared to how they felt inside themselves.
